Join us for this inspiring workshop with India Flint, internationally renowned botanical dye expert and innovator. The workshop runs from June 28 - July 2, from 10 am to 4 pm daily. The cost is \$485.00 (in Canadian Funds). For out-of-country participants, we require an international money order in Canadian Funds. We will send a registration form that can be filled out and returned by email to indicate your interest. However, we will only confirm your participation in the workshop once we have received payment. A materials list will be provided once you have secured a place in the workshop.
